## SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY UPDATED MAY 2009

The key principles upon which the uniform code is based are as follows.

**Uniform requirements should:**

- be simple, clear and unambiguous
- ensure student comfort
- be practical
- ensure health and safety of students
- help promote a school identity
- help promote school community cohesion
- help maintain a positive public image and reputation
- be affordable
- prevent inequality of opportunity

<b>Girls</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>School sweatshirt</b></li><li>• <b>White polo shirt (collar to be worn outside sweatshirt)</b></li><li>• <b>Plain black school type skirt or trousers (no miniskirts, denim or leggings)</b></li><li>• <b>Plain black footwear*</b></li></ul>
<b>Boys</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>School sweatshirt</b></li><li>• <b>White polo shirt (collar to be worn outside sweatshirt)</b></li><li>• <b>Plain black school type trousers (no denim)</b></li><li>• <b>Plain black footwear*</b></li></ul>
<b>General</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Jewellery – watches and stud earrings are acceptable.</b></li><li>• <b>Make-up – a reasonable amount is acceptable.</b></li><li>• <b>Small plain black belts are acceptable.</b></li><li>• <b>Uniform should be appropriate both with regard to the policy and in the judgement of the senior leadership team.</b></li></ul>

\*for health and safety reasons students will be expected to change their footwear for PE lessons.
