Material will include complex factual and abstract content and questions will target main points, gist and detail. Studio recordings will be used and students will have individual control of the recording. All questions are in French, to be answered in French (35 marks)</p> <p>Reading section Reading and responding to a variety of texts written for different purposes, drawn from a range of authentic sources and adapted as necessary. Material will include complex factual and abstract content and questions will target main points, gist and detail. All questions are in French, to be answered in French (45 marks).</p> <p>Writing section Translation into English; a passage of minimum 70 words (10 marks).</p> |
