How NetIDme works

By ensuring children know who they are talking to online, they are minimising the risk of being groomed or bullied. The NetIDme system continually re-enforces safe internet chat practices and rewards children for behaving safely online. This reward is in the form of an incentive scheme which encourages, motivates and teaches young internet users how to chat safely. Every time a NetIDme user identifies another user, they are awarded “points” which can then be exchanged for prizes on the NetIDme website – including cinema tickets, music downloads and iPods.

The NetIDme system operates exclusively on the internet and there is therefore no need for you to install special software on your home PC.

How to complete your child’s registration

1. Go to the NetIDme website at
2. Ask your child to login using their **email** address and **password**
3. Click **main menu** on the toolbar
4. When prompted click **complete registration**
5. Enter your details, and the promotional code: **QEHS1350**
6. Click **Retrieve Account Details**
7. Complete address details and confirm all information is correct.
8. Tick **terms and conditions** box
9. Finally, click **process subscription** to complete your child’s registration

An official NetIDme application form will then be posted to your home address, complete with the details already supplied for you to sign. The NetIDme identification process then requires the school to validate the details in the application form. Your child’s ICT teacher will authorise the application and the completed application form will be stamped as genuine by the school. It will then be returned to NetIDme Ltd who will complete the process. These steps are necessary to ensure all NetIDme users are genuine since both the school and parent/ guardian vouch for the identity of the child.
