BOTH YEARS **Virgin Money** are coming to QEHS to speak to Year 12 and Year 13 students about their **degree level apprenticeships** on Thursday 1 December 2016 at lunchtime (12.40pm to 1.15pm). This is a fantastic opportunity to hear **from the recruiters themselves** what they are looking for in applicants to these fantastic opportunities. Participants combine **earning and learning**, completing a digital degree in 4.5 years, **paid for by Virgin Money** and gaining **work experience** at the same time. The degree apprenticeship is based in **Gosforth**, Newcastle. Opportunities include Software Engineer, IT Consultant, Business Analyst, Network Engineer, and Data Analyst. Interested students should **sign up with the Curriculum Office**.

YEAR 13 The deadline to enter **resit entries** with the Exam Office is Friday 2 December 2016. Check the cost with the Exams Office or see the Exams section of the website; you will need a cheque to pay for your resits. Please note that information about exam resits is available **during break or lunchtime only**.

Additionally, if you want complete your **General Studies AS** (1 exam) or complete the **full A level** (3 exams), you need to fill in the General Studies form in the Exams Office. These exams are paid for by school.



YEAR 12 Elaine McStravick, our **Careers Adviser**, is in school on Wednesday 30 November 2016 and is available for students to book appointment with her to **talk about work experience** if they are **finding it hard to decide** where to apply to or **have not been successful** in their applications to date. University/College

YEAR 12 Oxford University are holding three taster/study days for Year 12 students in early 2017:

- **Corpus Christi College Philosophy Essay Prize and Taster Day** (14 February 2017, 10.15am – 3.30pm). The day will include a lecture and a number of introductory seminars to help students think about different areas of Philosophy that they may not have encountered in depth before. Lunch will be included, as will a chance to meet current undergraduates. The day is free of charge, and some help may be available with transport costs. Careers/Apprenticeships

YEAR 13 CGI, a large global IT Services provider, are now accepting applications for their **sponsored degree apprenticeship** vacancies across the UK.
