

Uniform

Parents are asked to co-operate with the school in maintaining uniform. The requirements are:

Girls

- Skirt/trousers - plain black
- Blouse/shirt - white with a collar
- Sweater/sweat shirt - black school sweatshirt
[except year 11 2004/2005]

Boys

- Trousers - plain black
- Shirt - white with a collar
- Sweater/sweat shirt - black school sweatshirt
[except year 11 2004/5]

Please note:

trousers should be black, standard school trousers not jeans, track suit bottoms, jogging pants or cut offs which are not classed as trousers;
when students wear a black top it should be plain, long sleeved and not hooded [year 11] or black school sweatshirt [year 9 & 10];
polo neck sweaters are not allowed;
polo shirts are acceptable but t-shirts are not;
no bare midriffs.

P.E & Games Clothing

- Girls**
 - sky blue polo shirt
 - games shirt
 - training shoes
 - green games kilt [optional]
 - games shorts navy blue/black
 - games socks, green/blue
- Boys**
 - white football shorts & rugby shorts
 - games shirt
 - sky blue polo shirt
 - games socks and rugby or football boots
 - training shoes

Students will be expected to wear appropriate boots and shin pads for games such as football, rugby and hockey.

Other Departments

Approved aprons must be worn for technical craft subjects and handling food.

Jewellery - Students may not wear any jewellery at all for P.E & Games

Sixth Form Dress

Members of Years 12 and 13 are not required to wear school uniform though they are expected to be suitable dressed at all times.
