Formal Exams

- ▶ Experience of sitting exams in a formal setting
- ▶ Exams let you practise revision strategies and discover what works best for you
- ▶ Testing yourself is an effective way to improve your knowledge and ability to recall information
- ▶ If you have a particularly bad exam, it is better to have the shock in the Y10 exam, than the final GCSE exam. It can act as a call to action that perhaps you need to do more work, change revision strategies and develop skills needed to perform under pressure

Formal Exam Information

- ▶ Seating plans will be displayed on the day of exams outside Pastoral Office for you to check where you are sitting (you have already had an exam timetable with a seat number on)

- ▶ Assemble at the back of the hall prior to the start of the exam
- ▶ You must be in school 20 minutes before the official exam start time - 8.55am for a morning exam and 12.55pm for an afternoon exam
- ▶ Period 3 will end at 12.20pm

- Mobile phones and web enabled technology **MUST** be handed in prior to exams or left at home - hand in at the back of the hall on a morning and the alcove for an afternoon exam

- ▶ You may take a clear bottle, no label into exams
- ▶ No sweets/snacks allowed
- ▶ No medicines allowed without prior permission
- ▶ No tissues (invigilators will provide tissues if you need them)

- ▶ No calculator lids
- ▶ Watches **MUST** be placed on the desk in view of invigilators
- ▶ Toilet breaks will not be allowed (except in exceptional circumstances)
