

Clothing /Items list for the skiing venture

| Ski Suit | Jacket etc. These need to be windproof and waterproof and are available for hire from Glide & Slide or locally at LD Mountain Centre in Newcastle. |
| Ski Gloves | These need to be waterproof and large enough that there is a small gap at the end of each finger so that the air can act as insulation |
| Goggles | These are essential on a snowy day. If you only wish to get either goggles or sunglasses please get the former. |
| Sunglasses | Must filter 100% UV. Optional. |
| Ski socks | Minimum of two pairs. |
| Base Layers | Layers of thin clothing are the most effective way to stay warm. Dependent on weather conditions two or three layers |
| Helmet | Compulsory – Included in the price and will be collected in the hotel. |
| Sun cream / Lip salve | Factor 16 is more than enough for normal skin types. |
| General Footwear | Footwear with a reasonable tread pattern |
| Pyjamas or Similar | Students will be in multi bedded rooms and need to have appropriate nightwear |
| Towel | Students need to provide their own towel |
| Qehs hoody | Students who have the school hoody should wear it during the journey. If there is sufficient demand we can order a ski venture hoody at a reasonable additional cost. |
| Swimwear | A traditional bathing costume. As mentioned at the ski presentation evening it may be possible for students to go to the newly opened spa centre for a small additional charge. [E10.00?] |
| Pillow/Blanket | Students may wish to take their own pillow and a thin blanket to make the journey more comfortable. |
| Suitcase/ Holdall | One medium sized holdall would be ideal for your ski clothing as luggage space will be at a premium; clothing for skiing is the priority whilst having several changes of casual clothing is a very low priority and is not really necessary. |

Mobile Phones / iPods etc.

Please be aware that these will need to be covered on your home insurance as they are not covered by the county policy. If they are not covered our advice would be that the student leaves them at home.
