YEAR 12 Reminder: **Nuffield Research Placements** give students the opportunity to **work alongside professional scientists, technologists, engineers and mathematicians for four weeks** over the summer holidays. Students work on a project that relates to an area of science, quantitative social science, computing, technology, engineering or maths (or a combination). Placements will be in the student's local area and are typically in organisations such as universities, research institutes, companies or voluntary organisations. Nuffield covers **travel costs** for all students and also offers **weekly bursaries** to students who meet certain **eligibility criteria**. Applying for the Research Placements involves an in-depth application process and a reference from the school.
