Hadrian Learning Trust (HLT), Northumberland County Council (NCC) and Galliford Try are pleased to invite you to a public drop-in event to showcase our proposals for the redevelopment of the Queen Elizabeth High School site, including the relocation of Hexham Middle School.

The proposals for the site include the refurbishment and extension of the historic Hydro building and Winter Garden, a new sports block, significantly improved external sports provision, and new car parking & bus drop off areas.

When completed, the redeveloped site will support the two distinct schools with separate facilities for each age group. The schools will have the same capacity as they do currently: Queen Elizabeth High School with capacity for 1,308 pupils (aged 13-18) and Hexham Middle School with capacity for 600 pupils (aged 9-13).

Galliford Try has been selected by NCC to design and deliver the redevelopment proposals.
