BOTH YEARS Askham Bryan College in York is a specialist land-based college with a number of undergraduate and foundation degree courses available in agriculture and countryside; arboriculture and horticulture; sport; animal management; equine; and veterinary nursing disciplines. YEAR 13 Newcastle University runs a supported entry scheme called the PARTNERS Programme. Through PARTNERS, eligible students could receive a lower offer for a place on their undergraduate courses than the University's typical offer, up to three grades lower. In addition, PARTNERS provides students with the opportunity to visit Newcastle University, make informed choices about higher education, develop skills to be successful at university, and meet other students before embarking on an undergraduate course. Acceptance to the PARTNERS scheme requires students to fulfil certain eligibility criteria (e.g. postcode, entitlement to Free School Meals, first to go to university, in care/young carer, disabilities/long-term health conditions) and successful completion of an Academic Summer School which takes place after the Year 13 exams.
