Year 10 English Literature - on Moodle page - English

1. Students have been asked to read 'Animal Farm' by George Orwell and were asked to complete the questions on chapters 1 and 2 for w/c 23rd and 30th March, chapters 3 and 4 w/c 20th April and chapter 5 w/c 4th May
2. Once students have completed all questions relating to these chapters they should email them to their English Literature teacher w/c 4th May. The English staff will read these answers and will provide model answers for the students to check their own answers against. This will enable students to see how and where they could improve their work.
3. If students have finished all the work above before 4th May, there are extension tasks that can be completed on the Year 10 English Literature Moodle page.
