

Submission of work for the English Department

Please read the information below and ask your son/daughter to submit work accordingly. All work is to be emailed to their English teacher as appropriate. **If you do not have access to internet/email, please ask your son/daughter to keep all work safely and be ready to hand into your English teacher when normal lessons resume.** Please contact school if you do not have internet and your son/daughter does not have paper copies of resources to complete any of the tasks; we will do our best to ensure these are sent out.

Please note that some deadlines are for immediately after what would have been the Easter holiday – this is not new work, rather the deadline for work that has been on-going since school closure.

I would be grateful if you would share this information with your son/daughter. This information guide has also been placed on the school website.

Year 12 English Literature

1. A OneDrive English Literature Year 12 folder has been created and shared with your son/daughter
2. Students can access different tasks and activities in dated folders for each side of the course, for example, 'Wuthering Heights/poetry' and 'Othello'. For the weekly tasks, there is an instructions sheet to clearly explain what is required. Also, it is explicit where we require the students to submit work for teacher assessment and feedback. The work for these texts will last until w/c 20th April.
3. W/c 20th April, we aim to launch the NEA (Non-Examined Assessment - which is essentially coursework) which is worth 20% of the final A Level grade. Here, the students will be given very clear guidance regarding the requirements of this piece of work and will follow simple steps that will hopefully ensure that the right texts are chosen and an appropriate title is negotiated with their teacher before they begin reading/writing.
