LESSONS:

VOCAB AND COMPREHENSION:

- Complete the weekly reading/writing tasks, just as you would for Mondays every week. Mark your homework using the answer slide.

OTHER POSSIBLE WEEKLY TASKS:

- **1. <u>Listening practice</u>** from Kerboodle: use the online book pages to click on the sound files: just listen for comprehension. Alternatively, select the 'resources' tab, and choose a topic we have covered, where the activity is 'interactive'.
- 2. <u>Reading practice</u> from Kerboodle (and languages online): opt for any activities that are 'interactive' on topics that we have covered in class.
- 3. Writing & Grammar practice: practise writing 40 words in German, under the following headings:
 - Mein Urlaub Meine Stadt Mein Lieblingsland
