Students must complete the following each week:

LESSONS:

- Complete the activities in the lesson files for the week. These will be in the form of a PowerPoint and/ worksheet.
- Follow the instructions in the PowerPoint / work sheet.
- Use the answer slides to correct your work in RED PEN, keeping scores in the margin.
- This work must be completed in your book (or on paper if you don't have your book) and will be checked when we return to school.

HOMEWORK (VOCABULARY AND COMPREHENSION/WRITTEN TASKS):

- We will tell you what we expect you to do for homework on the relevant PowerPoints.
- You will need to learn the weekly vocabulary list (this could be a set page of your vocabulary book or shown on a slide within the PowerPoint; a copy of the Year 9 French vocab book is also in Moodle).
- Complete the online **vocabulary test (quiz)** on Moodle and submit your responses. You must complete the vocab test within the week set, otherwise it will no longer be accessible. Please observe test conditions and do not use your list to help you.
- Complete the weekly **reading/writing tasks from your homework booklet**, as you would normally do. Again, we will make it clear what you are to do for homework on the relevant Powerpoint lessons. Mark your homework using the answer slide(s) in the next week's Powerpoint. You have 1 week to complete homework and vocabulary tests.

ADDITIONAL PRACTICE:

- Use the languages online (languages online.org.uk – français) website for French Revision
- Read through previous work in your exercise book – make revision cards / posters with the most useful tips, vocab, verbs & grammar, **especially the tenses. A secure knowledge of all year 9 work is vital for GCSE.**
- Languages Challenge / extra activities ideas in Moodle – all in the Year 9 French Moodle course.
- Broaden your knowledge of French culture even further by investigating a different tourist destination to those we will be studying this half term, but still within the French-speaking world.
- CHALLENGE: Use languages online to further your knowledge of vocabulary, grammar and tenses.
