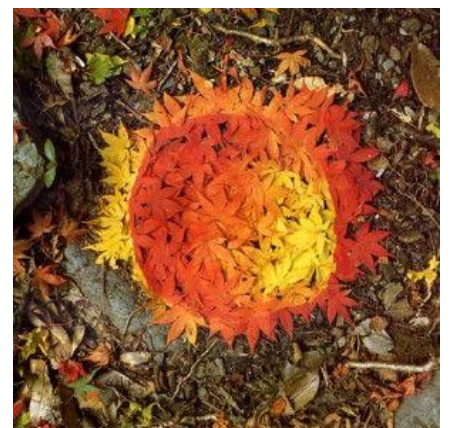


Tasks for Y11 Students moving to A-level Fine Art

- Your first task is to do a photoshoot in response to the artist Andy Goldsworthy (examples of his work below). You should research the artist first to expand your knowledge on the artist's style, concepts and processes.
- You should do a minimum of 20 photographs showing a range of installation pieces (roughly 3-4 pieces).



- Your second task is to do a 2D study from one of your photographs. This could be a sketch, painting, charcoal drawing, collage etc. We've put a couple of examples below but for more, visit our Pinterest board on natural form art for inspiration. <https://www.pinterest.co.uk/qehsartdepartment/natural-form-fine-art/>
- We understand you may not have access to lots of art materials so use whatever is available to you. We would recommend the study be roughly A3 size. Use this as a way to show us your artistic style, have fun with it!
