## Next phase of face-to-face support for year 10

Further to my letter to you on Friday, I am writing with more details regarding the above, where year 10 students will have a second opportunity to be in school, this time to benefit from mathematics and English teaching. Students will be grouped as they were for the first cycle, so that we limit mixing, and invited in on the same basis as before, i.e. on a specified day with a designated arrival time. The second cycle will commence on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> of July.

Letting us know your intentions if they have changed from the first cycle

- If your child <u>did not</u> attend as part of the first cycle but <u>would now like to</u> attend for the mathematics and English sessions, please let us know by completing this <u>survey</u>.
- If your child <u>did</u> attend as part of the first cycle but <u>will not</u> be attending for the mathematics and English sessions, please let us know by completing this <u>survey</u>.

## Please complete your responses by 9am on Thursday 25 June.

If your child is not attending the first cycle and also won't be attending the maths and English sessions, you don't need to do anything. Similarly, parents of students who are attending as part of the first cycle and who will also be attending the mathematics and English sessions need take no further action. We will assume they will be attending and will write to you with details of when they are due in.

## Next steps

To enable the taught sessions to be as productive as possible, in the next day or two we will send out details of tasks year 10s should complete at home in advance. We would appreciate your support in encouraging your son or daughter to ensure these are undertaken before they are due to be in. Please note, these will be sent to all students regardless of whether or not they will be in.

On Friday 26 June, we will write to parents of those intending to be in with details of the specific day and arrival and finish times, and a reminder of the expectations, e.g. no uniform, what to bring, etc.
