Topics to be covered in the assessment:	<p>Section A: Topic 4 - The UK's evolving physical landscape including coastal change and conflict but NOT River processes and pressures (this will be included in the February mock).</p> <p>Section B: Topic 5 - The UK's evolving human landscape Case Study – Dynamic UK cities – Incl. Newcastle case study</p> <p>Section C: Tectonics (This would normally be included in the Component 1 exam but we have included it in this assessment because we will not have had time to review and revise the river processes and pressures topic, you covered in lockdown).</p> <p>STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BRING A CALCULATOR INTO THE EXAM WITH THEM.</p>

ISBN-10: 1471887286</p> <p>Students will also have access to the Pearson online edition of the revision guide if they have bought the revision cards. These can be purchased via Schoolcomms and collected from the department</p>
In house booklets:	Students will have their tectonics booklet and exam question booklet to revise from.
For essay subjects and longer answer questions – suggested question titles for practice:	<p>Students will have to answer 8 mark questions. These will most likely have the command word 'assess', The definition for this is "Use evidence to determine the relative significance of something. Give consideration to all factors and identify which are the most Important". They need to structure their points in order of importance. A conclusion is not necessary if they have made a judgement throughout their answer.</p>
