Topics to be covered in the mock:	<p>Odyssey books 1-24; Aeneid Books 1-7 (extended questions will focus on family structures in the Odyssey or the character and depiction of Aeneas)</p> <p>Augustus and: Reforms of marriage and moral life. Conquest, military actions and his depiction as victor. His constitutional position as princeps and his claims to have restored the republic. (extended questions will focus on comparison of literary and physical evidence, or on whether Augustus was truly restoring the republic)</p>
