- **UCAS** have **extended** the **deadline** for applications to be considered equally to 6pm on the **29**th **January**. After this date it is still possible to apply but universities will only consider applications if they still have spaces available.
 - o If you have almost completed your application please 'pay and send' your online application as soon as possible so that your reference can be written and your application checked before the deadline.
 - If this extended deadline means that you would now like to apply please contact Joanne on curriculum@qehs.net urgently.
- 78 students have received decisions from one or more of their university choices.
 Once you have received offers from all of the universities you applied to please don't feel pressurised to make a quick decision about which to make your firm and insurance choice. If your application deadline was January you have until the 10th June to respond to your offers. Hopefully the restrictions will start to lift and you will get the chance to go and visit university departments before making your final decision.
