The Year in Industry (YINI), part of the Engineering Development Trust (EDT), is a not for profit organisation offering post A Level students a free extra resource when searching for a year out and paid work placements. These placements give students the opportunity to check out STEM careers, make informed decisions about which study or career path to take and can lead to sponsorship or apprenticeship opportunities. Candidates placed through the YINI scheme have access to additional mentor support, one day master classes and industrial accreditation. They work with companies all over the UK. Here is an example of a role currently available in Middlesbrough.

Location ----- Middlesbrough

Placement type----- Engineering/ Science - Materials related project work

Salary ----- £15,000 pa

Start date ----- September 2021 for 1 full year

Student type ----- Would suit a school Leaver taking a year out and then considering applying for a degree in Chemical, Mechanical or Electrical Engineering, Computer Science, Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics.
