# Centre Assessed Grades

- Any student completing a qualification this year (GCSE, A Level, AS Level, EPQ, BTEC, OCR) will have some part or all of their qualification predicted by their teachers
- Raw data & grades will be moderated and standardised by departments and then by the school
- Standardisation by the school needs to follow our regular patterns
- Do not ask staff about predicted grades or assessment scores!

# What will support CAGs?

- The knowledge/data that teachers currently hold on students from their 2 year courses through classwork, assessments, mocks, NEA, homework, bookwork, etc.
- Additionally GCSE students will complete 'checker' assessments to support with the CAG process.

# What will assessments look like?

- They will be in a style that you are familiar with for your subject
- No longer than 45 minutes for GCSE and covering small areas of the curriculum that you were revising for mocks or that has been recently taught
- You will be given very specific topic lists and revision to work on in lessons
- Art & Design – grades will be based on your portfolio

- We're still waiting for other school and subject specific guidance from the exam boards, which should come out over Easter, with some BTEC/OCR info out this week.
