


### 1. Your brand

Your globalbridge profile is your passport to your future, a digital record of your achievements, talents and aspirations. It is also a way to connect with REAL opportunities in education, employment and training.


Creating your globalbridge profile is really easy, but the next few pages will help you, as well as providing some top tips to make sure that you develop the best profile possible!



#### 1. HOW TO LOG IN

To log in you will need to go to the following website;



On the login page you need to enter your USERNAME and PASSWORD - these should have been given to you by your teacher.

If you don't have your username and password, or you can't remember them, don't worry! Click on the FORGOTTEN PASSWORD link and follow the instructions (if you are doing this, you will need access to you school / college EMAIL)

#### 2. ONBOARDING

If this is the first time you have logged in, you will go through a very quick ONBOARDING process.

#### **TOP TIP!**


If there is anything you can't or don't want to complete, that's fine! Just click the SKIP button in the top right-hand corner of the screen!

Have a click around - there are some great people on there!




#### 4. PROFILE EDIT



#### MY EXPERIENCES

This is a really key section. People want to see you have taken advantages of opportunities. You can record pretty much anything as an experience - events you've been to, talks, employment, workshops, work experience. To add an experience, click 'add another' then follow the steps...




#### **Key Details**

The first screen allows you to include basic info about the experience.

- Say who the experience was with where it says organisation (i.e. the name of the uni, employer.)
- Briefly explain what you did
- Give the start and end date (if the experience is still ongoing, put today's date in the end date)
- If the experience took place at your school/college, highlight this, if not, click external location
- Give the experience a rating from 1-5 stars.

#### Sector Details & Skills Used

After you have clicked SAVE you have the option to include extra details. We STRONGLY recommend you do this!

- Add information about the sector the experience was part of (a great way to show your interest in a particular area)
- Say what SKILLS you develop during the experience.
   People LOVE to see this!

#### MY QUALIFICATIONS

We know that you are more than a list of grades, but it is important that you include these on your profile. Entering your qualifications is really easy, and you should put any qualifications you have as well as those you are currently studying.





#### Select Type

After clicking 'add another' you need to select the type of qualification. Depending on your choice here, the next bit will look slightly different, but it should be really straightforward to complete. Below are some general tips to help you!



To save you repeating yourself, just click add another subject - it's at the bottom of the entry box!



#### **Predicted**

If you have not got the qualification yet (i.e. you are still studying, make sure you tick the 'predicted' box)



#### BTEC - Sector and Qualification Title

If you are entering BTECs, you need to select the sector the qualification belongs to from the drop down. In the Qualification Title field, write the name of the specific qualification (Fine Art, Business Administration, etc)





#### Other

Don't forget the 'OTHER' qualification - this can be used for any qualification you have gained or are doing!

Entering information is easy - just click 'add another' and select the relevant option.



#### MY MEDIA FILES

One of the most important parts of a your globalbridge profile is your media locker. Remember, opportunity providers want to SEE EVIDENCE of your skills and talents - this makes their job easier as you are showing that you are right for their opportunity.

You can upload a variety of media to evidence your skills, so think creatively. How can you show your talents in action?

You can include pictures, videos (use a YouTube Share URL), Soundcloud clips (again use the Share URL), PDFs, documents, PowerPoint files, Excel files... The only restriction is that the file size must be BELOW 25mb.

On the following pages you will see some top tips from our employer partners about use of media.

#### TOP TIP!

This is a great one - LOADS of our employer partners have said something they really like to see is a 30 second 'This Is Me' Selfie video. This doesn't just allow you to say a bit about who you are, but it also demonstrates your confidence, personality and communication skills. It might be a bit embarrassing, but it's totally worth it!




Let's get going...

Let's dive a little deeper into the careers that you are interested in...

Firstly, we are going to look at LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION (LMI). Now, this might sound pretty boring but it's actually really useful.

The Naional Careers Service explain what LMI is all about really well. They say that

'LMI effectively describes the world of work – ranging from descriptions of different careers, their entry routes, promotional prospects, salaries paid, skills and qualifications needed, etc.

Crucially for young people, LMI also covers future demand – what kinds of jobs will be in demand after leaving school and what kinds of skills will be needed?
