Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome to Y9 at Queen Elizabeth High School

I am writing to welcome you to Queen Elizabeth High School. We recognise the importance of the relationship between school and family to the success of our students. The continuing involvement of parents/carers in their child's learning will help to improve a student's outcomes and success. As part of your introduction to the high school we are inviting you to a Welcome Evening on **Wednesday 13 July.** This evening is for you, and you should not bring your child. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate the parents and children in the school hall. In order to manage numbers, could we please ask parents of Hexham Middle School pupils to arrive at 6pm and parents of pupils from all other schools to attend at 6.45pm. There will be tea and coffee on arrival followed by talks in the school hall and Q&A.

At the evening you will meet the key staff responsible for looking after your child in the High School. We will also explain the systems and procedures that will keep you informed about your child's progress. The Year 8 students will visit the high school on **Tuesday 12 July.** On that day students should wear their current school uniform and bring a pair of trainers with them in case they are required for PE.
