



Dear Parent/Carer and Y9 student,

We are looking forward to seeing the new Y9 students in September. I am writing to inform you about opportunities that will be available in the new term and inform students about the first day.

Start of term

Students are due in school on Wednesday 7 September. The school day begins at 8.40am and we advise arrival no later than 8.35am. For the first few days there will be no late sanction for Y9 but we will institute our late policy from Monday 12 September.

On the first day students will be in assembly and extended form time until the start of period 3 and then in lessons. It will be week one of the two-week timetable. On day one there are only Y9 students in school to support their induction.

Y9 will also be on first lunch sitting for the first few weeks of term.

Uniform

We believe that uniform is an important aspect of our safeguarding procedures but also part of being included and engaged in the life of the school. We expect students to be in school and wearing the correct uniform. You can find detailed information on our <u>website</u>.

A few key reminders:

- Students should wear black polishable shoes. This does not include canvas trainers or boots.
- Students should not wear hooded tops without zips to school (including QE branded hooded sweatshirts).
- Students should not wear their PE leggings to or from school as these are part of the PE kit and not the uniform.
- Students should wear grey school trousers, as per the specification on the website. Leggings/Jeggings are not acceptable.
