Paper to be sat:	Paper 1: a series of short answer questions assessing students' knowledge of core vocabulary/ literary terminology and context linked to 'Macbeth' and 'Modern Texts' (An Inspector Calls/ Animal Farm/ Journey's End)
	Paper 2: <i>Shakespeare's</i> Macbeth and 'Modern Texts' (as above)
Topics to be covered in the mock:	<p>Section A: 5 minutes total</p> <p>(i) Compulsory question on an extract taken from Macbeth – tests students' ability to evaluate ideas/themes presented in the extract and analyse the impact of Shakespeare's use of language, form and structure.</p> <p>(ii) A 'whole text' question on character or character clusters For this question, students must learn key quotations relevant for key characters also relevant context. This has been provided in the QEHS revision booklet.</p> <p>Section B: 'Modern Texts'(An Inspector Calls/ Animal Farm/ Journey's End) 50 minutes total Choice of x2 questions - choose ONE Questions will be on character and/or character clusters For this question, students must learn key quotations relevant for key characters also relevant context.
