Archaeology Bursaries available for students at the Vindolanda Charitable Trust

The Vindolanda Charitable Trust has ten bursary places for young people aged 16 interested in excavations.

Each bursary is worth £400 and includes: Excavation fees, including one excavation t-shirt, one year of Friends of Vindolanda membership, which allows unlimited, free entry at Roman Vindolanda and the Roman Army Museum and discounts in museum shops, lunch vouchers to the value of £85, in the form of a £8.50 per-day food and drink

voucher to be redeemed at the café facilities at Roman Vindolanda, £75 worth of travel expenses, in two tranches of £37.50, handed to the winners on the first and second Monday of participation.

"These are ten very much sought after places in what is a fully booked 2022 excavation programme at Vindolanda", a spokesperson said. "Students will be joining volunteers from around the world at one of the UK most exciting archaeological excavations.
