- **December 2** @ **12:00 13:00** insight4me Engineering: Practical Applications of Physics Principles Sheffield & Glasgow (KS5) Dr Ian Taylor, the Head of Aerospace Engineering at University of Glasgow, will examine how the principles of flight are based on some of the fundamental laws of physics, from Newton's Laws of Motion to Conservation of Energy, and involve many aspects of science from materials, thermodynamics, mechanics and fluid dynamics. Ian will discuss how this application of principles is not always straightforward. Dr Gavin Williams from The University of Sheffield will then discuss the development of the Blue LED, which was awarded the 2014 Nobel Prize for Physics. Explaining the physics behind these tiny devices, Gavin will look at how these LEDs have produced a lighting revolution and will suggest how they may soon be giving us an even better internet connection.
