X 3 weeks	Students will revisit knowledge and skills acquired for critical reading of an unseen 19 th century extract. At this stage it is anticipated that the majority of students are able to respond to questions as they would in an exam situation. Approaches to analysis of writer's craft and evaluation of writer's intent approached with enhanced stylistic maturity.

Autumn Term 2 X2 weeks RETENTION SPAG 3	Poetry : students will revisit previous knowledge of GCSE poetry studied and study a new collection of the poetry cluster with a connecting overarching theme. Students will be encouraged to make links to previously studied poems and refine with increasing sophistication their ability to analyse unseen poetry and synthesise texts for comparative purpose. Paired Poems are: 'Where the Picnic Was' and 'Absence'/ 'Stewart Island' and 'FF' and 'Adlestrop'/' Nothing's Changed' and 'Postcard from a Travel Snob'
X1 week	Spoken Language Endorsement: Students will choose a topic that they feel strongly about and revisit prior learning from Y10, refine their knowledge of argue/persuade and develop their knowledge and understanding of appropriate stylistic convention to effectively script and present their viewpoint in a formal setting
Autumn Term 2	Non-Fiction Reading: Students will revisit and develop critical reading knowledge and extend analytical and evaluation skills by reading a range of
X 4weeks	non-fiction texts, including memoirs, letters and articles linked to the theme of remembrance. Students will synthesise texts in an increasingly complex, synoptic way. Literature: Students will refine unseen poetry skills and refine critical reading skills when revising 'A Christmas Carol'. Students are encouraged to consider the broadest ideas raised in the text and approach texts with independent thought. Students will revise anthology poetry – analysis of

	language, form and structure with enhanced sophistication – students to use transferable practical criticism knowledge and skills for unseen poetry analysis.
