A reminder about our uniform expectations.

The uniform policy can be found <u>here</u>. To ensure clarity and consistency please see further guidance on some areas:

- **Grey pleated skirts** should not be unduly short. As a guide a skirt should not be rolled and should come below the fingertip when arms are held by the side.
- Grey formal trousers no black trousers, leggings or tracksuit bottoms.
- **Hair Colour** hair should not be dyed an extreme unnatural colour. This includes blues, greens, pinks, reds and purples.
- White school shirts top buttons should be fastened, and shirts should be tucked in.
- School tie these should be worn at all times.
- **No jewellery** apart from single, stud earrings. No nose piercings can be worn. All piercings must be removed for practical PE lessons.
- Black polishable shoes.

Attendance

Leave of Absence During Term Time

Parents who take their child out of school without authorisation may be fined. The amount of the fine depends on how quickly it is paid: £80 if paid within 21 days; this rises to £160 if paid within 22 to 28 days of the notice being issued; if the fine is not paid the parent can be prosecuted. Both parents may be fined for the same absence. (Hexham Partnership of Schools Policy on Leave of Absence During Term Time)




LRC recommended read
