For a student to achieve **Excelling** in a strand of our school ethos, in addition to meeting the criteria for **Good** for that strand, they should also be consistently demonstrating meeting more than two of the criteria for Exceeding.

Exceeding

For a student to achieve **Exceeding** for **Respect**, in addition to meeting the criteria for Good, they should also be consistently demonstrating one or two of the following;

- they are a role model for other students by having significantly high standards which helps raise the standards of their peers.
- additional kindness and positivity that significantly impacts on others.
- actively helping and supporting others.
- · leadership skills which contribute positively to the school ethos.
- that they accept and celebrate the differences and diversity within our school community.

For a student to achieve **Exceeding** for **Engage**, in addition to meeting the criteria for Good, they should also be consistently demonstrating one or two of the following;

- a love of learning by showing significant enthusiasm and positivity in lessons.
- · significant sustained effort over time.
- significant responsibility for their learning by ensuring that there are no gaps in their knowledge and all work is up-to-date. Any work missed due to absence is caught up.
- they have consistently accessed the additional help and support available to them to ensure they make progress with their learning.
- significant creativity and/or innovation.
- · they can use their initiative to effectively problem solve to benefit their learning.
- participation in subject based extra-curricular activities.

For a student to achieve **Exceeding** for **Aspire**, in addition to meeting the criteria for Good, they should also be consistently demonstrating one or two of the following:

- significant enthusiasm for their learning by extending their learning beyond compulsory independent work.
- a relentless approach to their learning by showing significant ambition to succeed.
- curiosity by being pro-active in seeking additional learning opportunities and challenge to enhance their learning.
- significant determination/resilience by overcoming challenges/barriers to achieve success.
- that they are actively looking at the future by researching their next steps.

For a student to achieve **Good** for **Respect** they should be consistently demonstrating that they;

- are polite by having good manners.
- show courtesy and consideration towards others.
- follow the school rules and meet behaviour expectations.
- act upon staff instruction first time, every time, to maintain a calm and safe learning environment.
- act with integrity and take responsibility for their actions.
- are respectful to the school environment and equipment, and the equipment of others.
- can work effectively and collaboratively with their peers when required to do so.
- take responsibility for their organisation to ensure they are punctual to lessons.
- actively listen to others and can respond thoughtfully when appropriate.

For a student to achieve **Good** for **Engage** they should be consistently demonstrating that they;

- are **ready to learn** by bringing the required equipment to
- are motivated by giving the required effort to complete tasks to the best of their ability.
- · take care and pride in their work by ensuring their work is organised and they meet presentation expectations.
- · can work independently in lessons by showing focus and concentration.
- can contribute positively to lessons by being actively engaged in the lesson.
- take responsibility for their own learning by actively seeking help when it is required.
- listen to and immediately respond to feedback given in lessons to ensure work is improved.

For a student to achieve **Good** for **Aspire** they should be consistently demonstrating that they;

- complete homework/assignments for given deadlines.
- complete homework/assignments to the best of their ability.
- take responsibility by seeking help with homework/assignments in advance of deadlines, to ensure it is completed to the best of their ability.
- attend appropriate drop-in opportunities when additional support is required with homework/assignments.
- have the motivation to prepare and revise independently in advance of assessments.
- listen to and immediately **respond to feedback** given for work completed outside of lessons to ensure it is improved.
- have resilience through accepting appropriate challenge.

Required Improvement Cause for Concern [5]

For a student to be judged as Inconsistent they are not yet consistently demonstrating up to three of the Attitude to Learning criteria for Good and improvement is required. They should focus on improving their Attitude to Learning to meet our school expectations. At this level, their current attitude to learning increases the risk of underachievement and is likely to negatively impact academic achievement and progress. If they are unsure which criteria they are not yet meeting, they should take responsibility by speaking to their subject teacher.

For a student to be judged as Cause for Concern they are not yet consistently demonstrating more than three of the Attitude to Learning criteria for Good and improvement is required. They should focus on improving their Attitude to Learning to meet our school expectations. At this level, their current attitude to learning significantly increases the risk of underachievement and will negatively impact academic achievement and progress.
