Dear Parent/Carer

Musical Instrument and Voice Tuition at QEHS

If your child would like to start or to continue playing a musical instrument or learn singing, we have a wide range of music tuition available at QEHS (see list on pages 2 and 3). If your child has received musical instrument or voice tuition at their current school, they will be able to continue tuition on the same instrument at HMS or they may wish to start learning an instrument or voice as a beginner.

The vast majority of our peripatetic music staff are contracted on a self-employed basis and contracts are arranged between parents and the instrument teacher in advance of lessons starting. All fees are paid directly to the teacher. Where the music teacher (drums, accordion, harp) is contracted by Music Parnership North, fees are paid directly to that organisation, but the teacher will give you information about this when you get in touch.

You can find out specific information such as the cost of lessons once you are in touch with the relevant teacher. It is common practice for lessons to be paid termly or in blocks of ten lessons but always in advance of lessons starting. Most lessons are taught on a one-to-one basis though some teachers offer small group lessons.

Lesson times will generally rotate on a weekly basis to prevent pupils missing the same curriculum lesson each week. All instrument teachers provide timetables to be displayed in school as well as sending them to you directly. Please note that if a pupil misses a lesson, it is still chargeable; though if you give the teacher enough advance warning, they will endeavour to move the lesson time, for example: in the event of a school trip taking place.

All of our teachers are highly qualified and several perform professionally. All teach to exam standard, and all children will have the opportunity, if they wish, to take recognised examinations with exam boards such the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music; Trinity & Guildhall; RSL.

- We will provide the room facilities in school time for the tuition

- Deal directly with the music tutor regarding any quality assurance matters
- Pay invoices will be direct to the tutor as per their terms and conditions
- Give permission for the school to pass this contact information to the relevant music tutor (as per form which is linked in this email).
