Course Title	LAMDA Grade 8 Speaking in Public: Gold Award (Enhancement Course)

Our LAMDA Gold Speaking in Public course offers students a prestigious opportunity to develop advanced communication, presentation, and confidence skills. Delivered through two sessions per week, the programme blends practical workshops with focused theory to prepare learners for the Grade 8 examination.

Students take part in regular rehearsal and technique based activities, building vocal clarity, physical presence, and audience engagement. Alongside this, they are guided through the process of crafting two original speeches, from selecting and researching topics to structuring, writing, refining, and performing them. Learners also develop the ability to give articulate, informed responses to knowledge based questions and gain confidence through regular impromptu speaking practice.

Running from September through to the public examination at the Newcastle Centre in June, this course provides a highly supportive yet challenging environment that equips students with exceptional public-speaking skills and a nationally recognised qualification.
