Paper to be sat:	<i>English Literature – Journey’s End and Anthology Poetry</i>
Topics to be covered in the mock:	<p>Section A: ‘Journey’s End’ Students will be given a choice of two questions for the set text of ‘Journey’s End’. This will be on a character / character cluster or a theme. The focus for the mock: Osborne / Stanhope / the Relationship between Osborne and Raleigh / Youth vs Age / Camaraderie They will choose one of the two questions and write a response. They will use PEEL/EEL/EEL structure and context. Students have 50 minutes to complete this question. Total marks: 40</p> <p>Section B: Anthology Poetry Students are going to respond to a poetry question based on the anthology poems. This is a comparison question and they will be given one of the following poems: London / Home Thoughts from Abroad / Where the Picnic Was / Absence / Postcard from a Travel Snob They will compare the given poem to one other from the Time and Place anthology. They will not have a copy of the poem they choose to compare and knowledge will need to come from their revision. They will use PETERPETE structure and context. Students have 35 minutes to complete this question.</p>
