Questions assess: • Inference and Deduction skills (Multiple Choice) [4] • Ability analyse writers’ use of language [8] • Ability analyse writers’ use of structure [8] • Ability to evaluate a statement and articulate the extent in which they agree [20] Section B: Imaginative Writing Students have a choice of x2 questions; one based on an image to do a description of, and one based on a statement to write the opening to a story. his question assesses students’ ability to: • Use varied paragraphs, sentences and punctuation for a deliberate effect • Conscious use of structure for deliberate effect • Use a range of appropriate vocabulary for effect and to suit purpose and audience • Spelling, punctuation, and grammar are accurate
